- 1) Each waste stream will be determined on a case-by-case basis by MAWSA following review of analytical results provided by the waste hauler prior to acceptance.
- 2) TSS Surcharge is as follows:
  - a. Greater than 2% up to and including 4% - Additional 30% of base fee – 25% for septage/holding
  - b. Greater than 4% up to and including 5% - Additional 60% of base fee – 50% for septage/holding
  - c. Greater than 5% - case by case basis

3) Process fines:

- a. Manifests - \$20 per error or incomplete field
- b. Sample Cups - \$20 per error or incomplete field, additional \$50 if sample is not submitted for testing
- c. Station Cleaning – Neglecting to spray and clean pad of residual liquid waste after disconnecting or spilling - \$40
  - i. Neglecting to clear offload hose before disconnecting/leaving hose full - \$75
- d. Incorrect Offload Destination – Base fine of \$100, additional charges applied on a case-by-case basis if occurrence is determined to have damaged treatment in any way.

All charges will be invoiced to the permitted hauler at the end of every billing cycle. Each unique load will be tested and categorized according to its TSS, and pH as determined by the sample analysis taken at the facility. Delinquent Hauled Waste Invoices: A 5% penalty will be applied 30-days after the invoice date. MAWSA NON-Standard Permit Fee is \$250.00 per application, MAWSA requires an approved NON-Standard Permit for each NON-Standard generator source.
